zivik Funding Programme Funding opportunities for Unidas Network members



Collaboration between ifa's zivik Funding Programme and Unidas Network:

The zivik Funding Programme by the Institut für Auslandsbeziehungen (ifa) provides Unidas members with the chance to finance multiple projects each year, promoting dialogue, interaction, and peace.

The **zivik Funding Programme** supports civil society projects that contribute to civil conflict resolution. The programme includes funding from the German Federal Foreign Office, advisory support throughout the project process, and exchanges between civil society actors and with experts in politics and science.

Which projects are eligible for funding?

Projects and measures aimed at:

- Prevent potential clashes
- Overcoming ongoing conflicts
- Supporting peace-building in post-conflict contexts

Possible topics:

- Mediation and dialogues
- Reconciliation, dealing with the past, transitional justice
- Conflict resolution from the Women, Peace and Security
 (WPS) agenda perspective
- Support to civil society and governance structures
- Prevention of extremism and de-radicalization

Projects may be located in one or several countries, but a lead implementer must be appointed.



Which projects are not eligible for funding?

- Projects without specific reference to a conflict
- Projects with a **general focus** on inequality, discrimination against women or women's empowerment
- Projects that have already started



- Members of the Unidas Network in Latin America, the Caribbean and Germany, with focus on project implementation in Latin America and the Caribbean
- Only registered NGOs can apply for funding



Organisations funded by zivik Funding Programme for the first time:

- Maximum amount of financing: 100,000 euros
- The project should be completed in the same year

Organisations that have already received funding from zivik Funding Programme:

- Maximum amount of funding: 400,000 euros per year
- Financing for up to 2 years is possible

Successful projects can be funded for a period of up to 3 years in total.

The implementing organisation must be in a position to manage the project administratively.

How to apply?

- Submission of a project outline (max. 3 pages) to <u>zivik@ifa.de</u> (recommended until June/July for project funding in the following year).
- 2. If the project outline receives a positive response, organisations will be invited to submit a full application (until 1 October for project funding in the following year).

The zivik Funding Programme offers advice and assistance at all stages of the process.
